Section 1132 of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C.

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7 1320b-2) is amended—

1	(1) in subsection (a), in the matter following
2	paragraph (2)—
3	(A) by inserting "(or, in the case of ex-
4	penditures made by the State during a calendar
5	quarter beginning on or after January 1, 2021,
6	in carrying out the State plan approved under
7	title XIX, within the one-year period)" after
8	"within the two-year period"; and
9	(B) by inserting "(or such one-year pe-
10	riod)" after "such two-year period"; and
11	(2) in subsection (b)—
12	(A) in the first sentence, by striking "if
13	he" and inserting "if the Secretary"; and
14	(B) by adding at the end the following new
15	sentence: "In the case of such a waiver made
16	on or after January 1, 2019, with respect to
17	the filing of a claim for payment with respect
18	to expenditures in carrying out the State plan
19	approved under title XIX, the Secretary shall
20	publicly post on the website of the Department
21	of Health and Human Services a general notice
22	of such waiver and the reason for such waiver,
23	not later than 30 days after the date on which
24	such waiver is so made.".
