3	"(F)(i) With respect to a targeted test or proce-

5	2018 or a subsequent year (before 2028) to an indi-
6	vidual in an ambulatory surgical center, the payment
7	amount for such test or procedure that would other-
8	wise be determined under the revised payment sys-
9	tem under subparagraph (D), without application of
10	this subparagraph, shall be equal to the payment
11	amount for such test or procedure furnished in
12	2016.
13	"(ii) For purposes of clause (i), the term 'tar-
14	geted test or procedure' means a test or procedure
15	to which Health Care Procedure Coding System
16	62264, 62321, 62323, 64490, 64493, or G0260 ap-
17	plies.".
18	(b) Data Collection.—The Secretary of Health
19	and Human Services shall collect data relating to the cost
20	differential between hospital outpatient services performed
21	in a hospital operating room and those performed in an
22	office setting within a hospital in order to determine
23	whether such services are being properly coded for claims,
24	based on setting, for payment under section 1833(i)(2)(D)
25	of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1395l(i)(2)(D)) and

- 3 (as described in section 1833(t)(2)(A) of the Social Secu-
