5 303(g)(2)(G)(iii)(I) of the Controlled Substances Act (21
6 U.S.C. 823(g)(2)(G)(iii)(I)) treating 100 or more patients,
7 with recommendations on future applicable patient number levels and limits. In preparing such report, the Secretary shall study, with respect to opioid use disorder
8 treatment—

10 (1) the average frequency with which qualifying
11 practitioners see their patients;

12 (2) the average frequency with which patients
13 receive counseling;

14 (3) the average frequency with which random
15 toxicology testing is administered;

16 (4) the average monthly patient caseload for
17 each type of qualifying practitioner;

18 (5) the treatment retention rates for patients;

19 and

1 (6) overdose and mortality rates.
