**SUBJECT: Subcommittee Virtual Hearing on “Improving Access to Care:
Legislation to Reauthorize Key Public Health Programs”**

The Subcommittee on Health of the Committee on Energy and Commerce will hold a virtual, fully remote hearing at **10 a.m. (EDT) on Wednesday, July 29, 2020**. The hearing is entitled, “Improving Access to Care: Legislation to Reauthorize Key Public Health Programs.” Witnesses will be by invitation only.

This is a legislative hearing that will focus on the following attached bills:

1. **H.R. 2075**, the “**School-Based Health Centers Reauthorization Act of 2019**” (*Reps. Sarbanes, Tonko, Stefanik, and Upton*).
2. **H.R. 4078**, the “**EARLY Act Reauthorization of 2019**” (*Reps. Wasserman Schultz and Brooks of IN*).
3. **H.R. 4439**, the “**Creating Hope Reauthorization Act**” (*Reps. Butterfield, McCaul, Speier, Kelly of PA, Engel, Bilirakis, Kelly of IL, Hudson, Rush, and Mullin*).
4. **H.R. 4764**, the “**Timely ReAuthorization of Necessary Stem-cell Programs Lends Access to Needed Therapies Act of 2019**” or the “**TRANSPLANT Act of 2019**” (*Reps. Matsui, Bilirakis, and Pingree*).
5. **H.R. 5373**, the “**United States Anti-Doping Agency Reauthorization Act of 2019**” (*Reps. Thompson of CA, Johnson of OH, and DeGette*).

This hearing will take place remotely via Cisco Webex online video conferencing. For Members only access, Committee staff will email Webex access information later this week.
