3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Lead Poisoning Pre-
- 5 vention Act of 2021".

1SEC. 2. SCREENINGS, REFERRALS, AND EDUCATION RE-2GARDING LEAD POISONING.

Section 317A(l)(1) of the Public Health Service Act
(42 U.S.C. 247b-1(l)(1)) is amended by striking
"\$40,000,000 for fiscal year 1993, and such sums as may
be necessary for each of the fiscal years 1994 through
2005" and inserting "\$46,000,000 for each of fiscal years
2022 through 2026".

9 SEC. 3. GRANTS FOR LEAD POISONING RELATED ACTIVI10 TIES.

Section 3170 of the Public Health Service Act (42
U.S.C. 247b–16) is amended by striking "such sums as
may be necessary for each of the fiscal years 2001 through
2005" and inserting "\$17,000,000 for each of fiscal years
2022 through 2026".

16 SEC. 4. ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON CHILDHOOD LEAD POI17 SONING PREVENTION.

18 Section 317B(a)(2) of the Public Health Service Act
19 (42 U.S.C. 247b–3(a)(2)) is amended to read as follows:
20 "(2) ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON CHILDHOOD

21 LEAD POISONING PREVENTION.—

"(A) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary may establish a council to be known as the Advisory
Committee on Childhood Lead Poisoning Prevention (in this paragraph referred to as the
'Advisory Committee').

2	mittee shall include the following members (or
3	their designee):
4	"(i) The Secretary, who shall serve as
5	the chair of the Advisory Committee.
6	"(ii) The Director of the Centers for
