SUBCOMMITTEE ON HEALTH
HYBRID MARKUP

WEDNESDAY, MAY 11, 2022

The Subcommittee on Health of the Committee on Energy and Commerce met, pursuant to notice, at 10:19 a.m., a quorum being present, for a hybrid markup in the John D. Dingell Room, 2123 of the Rayburn House Office Building and on the Committee's WebEx platform, Hon. Anna Eshoo (Chairwoman of the subcommittee) presiding. The business before the Subcommittee was consideration and markup of six bills. The following actions were taken:

1. [H.R. 7667](#), the "Food and Drug Amendments of 2022," was ordered reported favorably to the full Committee, **amended**, by a roll call vote of 30 yeas to 0 nays ([HE Roll Call No. 1](#)) (**Final Passage**).

The following amendment was offered during consideration of H.R. 7667:

- **An Amendment in the nature of a substitute (AINS) #1** ([H7667-scd-AINS_01](#)), offered by Ms. Eshoo, was agreed to by a voice vote.
- **An Amendment to the AINS #1a** ([CARTGA_079](#)), offered by Mr. Carter, was withdrawn.
- **An Amendment to the AINS #1b** ([H7667-SCD-MATSUI_01](#)), offered by Ms. Matsui, was withdrawn.
- **An Amendment to the AINS #1c** ([CURTUT_98](#)), offered by Mr. Curtis, was withdrawn.

2. [H.R. 7666](#), the "Restoring Hope for Mental Health and Well-Being Act of 2022," was ordered reported favorably to the full Committee, **without amendment**, by a roll call vote of 32 yeas to 0 nays ([HE Roll Call No. 2](#)) (**Final Passage**).

No amendments were offered during consideration of H.R. 7666.

3. [H.R. 7233](#), the "Keeping Incarceration Discharges Streamlined for Children and Accommodating Resources in Education Act" or "KIDS CARES Act," was ordered reported favorably to the full Committee, **amended**, by a roll call vote of 32 yeas to 0 nays ([HE Roll Call No. 3](#)) (**Final Passage**).

The following amendment was offered during consideration of H.R. 7233:

- **An Amendment in the nature of a substitute (AINS) #1** ([H7233-SC-AINS_01](#)), offered by Mr. Hudson, was agreed to by a voice vote.
- **An Amendment to the AINS #1a** ([PEDS-BHCARE-AMD_01](#)), offered by Ms. Eshoo, was agreed to by a voice vote.

- **An Amendment #2** ([BURGES 140](#)), offered by Mr. Burgess, was withdrawn.
- **An Amendment to the AINS #1b** ([H7233-SC-amd 01](#)), offered by Ms. Blunt Rochester, was agreed to by a voice vote.
- **An Amendment #3** ([BURGES 141](#)), offered by Mr. Burgess, was withdrawn.

4. [H.R. 623](#), the “Gabriella Miller Kids First Research Act 2.0,” was ordered reported favorably to the full Committee, **amended**, by a voice vote. **(Final Passage)**.

The following amendment was offered during consideration of H.R. 623:

- **An Amendment in the nature of a substitute (AINS) #1** ([H623-SCD-AINS 01](#)), offered by Ms. Castor, was agreed to by a voice vote.

5. [H.R. 3771](#), the “South Asian Heart Health Awareness Act of 2021,” was ordered reported favorably to the full Committee, **amended**, by a voice vote. **(Final Passage)**.

The following amendment was offered during consideration of H.R. 3771:

- **An Amendment #1** ([H3771-SCD-MNGR 01](#)), offered by Mr. Pallone, was agreed to by a voice vote.

6. [H.R. 5585](#), the “Advanced Research Project Agency-Health Act” or “ARPA-H Act,” was ordered reported favorably to the full Committee, **without amendment**, by a voice vote. **(Final Passage)**.

No amendments were offered during consideration of H.R. 5585.
