**A BILL**

To amend title XVIII of the Social Security Act to extend incentive payments for participation in eligible alternative payment models.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “[\_\_\_\_\_] Act of  
5 2023”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXTENDING INCENTIVE PAYMENTS FOR PARTICIPA-**  
2 **TION IN ELIGIBLE ALTERNATIVE PAYMENT**  
3 **MODELS.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1833(z) of the Social Se-  
5 curity Act (42 U.S.C. 1395l(z)) is amended—

6 (1) in paragraph (1)—

7 (A) in subparagraph (A)—

8 (i) by striking “In the case” and in-  
9 serting “Subject to subparagraph (E), in  
10 the case”;

11 (ii) by striking “ending with 2025”  
12 and inserting “ending with 2026”; and

13 (iii) by inserting “and 2026” after  
14 “with respect to 2025”; and

15 (B) by adding at the end the following new  
16 subparagraph:

17 “(E) 5-YEAR CAP ON PAYMENT INCEN-  
18 TIVE.—An eligible professional that is a quali-  
19 fying APM participant with respect to a year  
20 described in subparagraph (A) may not receive  
21 payment under this subsection for such year if  
22 such professional has previously received pay-  
23 ment under this subsection for more than 4  
24 other years.”;

25 (2) in paragraph (2)—

26 (A) in subparagraph (B)—

1 (i) in the subparagraph heading, by  
2 striking “2025” and inserting “2026”; and

3 (ii) in the matter preceding clause (i),  
4 by striking “2025” and inserting “2026”;  
5 (B) in subparagraph (C)—

6 (i) in the subparagraph heading, by  
7 striking “2026” and inserting “2027”; and

8 (ii) in the matter preceding clause (i),  
9 by striking “2026” and inserting “2027”;

10 and

11 (C) in subparagraph (D), by striking  
12 “2024, and 2025” and inserting “2024, 2025,  
13 and 2026”; and

14 (3) in paragraph (4)(B), by striking “2025”  
15 and inserting “2025 and 2026”.

16 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—Section  
17 1848(q)(1)(C)(iii) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C.  
18 1395w–4(q)(1)(C)(iii) is amended—

19 (1) in subclause (II), by striking “2025” and  
20 inserting “2026”; and

21 (2) in subclause (III), by striking “2026” and  
22 inserting “2027”.
