- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Telehealth Privacy Act
- 5 of 2023".

1	SEC. 2. MAINTAINING CERTAIN TELEHEALTH FLEXIBILI-
2	TIES RELATING TO PROVIDER PRIVACY
3	UNDER THE MEDICARE PROGRAM.
4	Section 1834(m) of the Social Security Act (42
5	U.S.C. 1395m(m)) is amended by adding at the end the
6	following new paragraph:
7	"(10) Ensuring physician and practi-
8	TIONER PRIVACY.—In the case of a physician or
9	practitioner who elects to furnish telehealth services
10	at a distant site that is the residence of such physi-
11	cian or practitioner, if the Secretary requires such
12	physician or practitioner to include the address of
13	such residence on any enrollment form of such phy-
14	sician or practitioner under this title (or requires
15	such physician or practitioner to bill for such serv-
16	ices using such address), the Secretary may not
17	make such address available to the public in any
18	manner.".
