7 (i) in subparagraph (B), by striking “;
8 or” and inserting a semicolon;

9 (ii) in subparagraph (C), by striking
10 the period and inserting “; or”; and

11 (iii) by adding at the end the fol-
12 lowing:

13 “(D) acquire drugs or devices approved,
14 cleared, or otherwise legally marketed under the
15 Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act for
16 emergency treatment of known or suspected
17 overdose.”;

18 (3) by striking subsection (f);

19 (4) by redesignating subsection (g) as sub-
20 section (f);

21 (5) in subsection (f)(1), as so redesignated, by
22 striking “2019 through 2023” and inserting “2025
23 through 2029”;

24 (6) by redesignating such section 330J as sec-
25 tion 553 of the Public Health Service Act; and

1 (7) by transferring such section 553, as so re-
2 designated, to appear at the end of part D of title
3 V of the Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C.
4 290dd et seq.).
