3 populations, including individuals with develop-
4 mental disabilities such as Down syndrome,”
5 after “populations”; and

6 (B) by striking “; and” and inserting a
7 semicolon;

8 (4) by redesignating paragraph (6) as para-
9 graph (7); and

10 (5) by inserting after paragraph (5) the fol-
11 lowing:

12 “(6) provide information on, and promote the
13 adoption of, healthy behaviors that may reduce the
14 risk of cognitive decline and promote and protect
15 cognitive health; and”.

16 (b) NATIONAL PLAN.—Section 2(d)(2) of the Na-
17 tional Alzheimer’s Project Act (42 U.S.C. 11225(d)(2)) is
18 amended—

19 (1) by inserting “, across public and private
20 sectors,” after “Nation’s progress”; and

21 (2) by inserting “, including consideration of
22 public-private collaborations, as appropriate” before
23 the period at the end.

1 (c) ADVISORY COUNCIL.—Section 2(e) of the Na-
2 tional Alzheimer’s Project Act (42 U.S.C. 11225(e)) is
3 amended—

4 (1) in paragraph (2)—

5 (A) in subparagraph (A), by adding at the
6 end the following:

7 “(xi) A designee of the Department of
8 Justice.

9 “(xii) A designee of the Social Secu-
10 rity Administration.

11 “(xiii) A designee of the Federal
12 Emergency Management Agency.

13 “(xiv) 2 or more other designees of
14 the Department of Health and Human
15 Services, at least one of whom has exper-
16 tise in risk factors associated with the de-
17 velopment or the progression of Alz-
18 heimer’s disease, as determined by the Sec-
19 retary of Health and Human Services.”;
20 and

21 (B) in subparagraph (B)—

22 (i) in the matter preceding clause (i),
23 by striking “12” and inserting “14”;

24 (ii) in clause (v)—

1 (I) by striking “2 researchers”
2 and inserting “3 researchers”; and

3 (II) by striking “; and” and in-
4 serting “, including at least one re-
5 searcher with demonstrated experience
6 in recruitment and retention of under-
7 represented groups into research or
8 clinical trials related to dementia;”;

9 (iii) in clause (vi), by striking the pe-
10 riod at the end and inserting “; and”; and

11 (iv) by adding at the end the fol-
12 lowing:

13 “(vii) 1 individual with a diagnosis of
14 Alzheimer’s disease.”;

15 (2) in paragraph (5)—

16 (A) in subparagraph (A)—

17 (i) by striking “an initial evaluation”
18 and inserting “annual evaluations”; and

19 (ii) by striking “research, clinical”
20 and inserting “research, risk reduction,
21 public health, clinical”;

22 (B) in subparagraph (B), by striking “ini-
23 tial” and inserting “annual”;

24 (C) in subparagraph (C)—

1 (i) in the matter preceding clause (i),
2 by striking “initial” and inserting “an-
3 nual”; and

4 (ii) in clause (ii), by inserting “and
5 reduce disparities” before the semicolon at
6 the end; and

7 (D) in subparagraph (D), by striking “an-
8 nually thereafter, an evaluation” and inserting
9 “annual evaluations”; and
10 (3) in paragraph (6), by striking “2025” and
11 inserting “2035”.

12 (d) ANNUAL REPORT.—Section 2(g) of the National
13 Alzheimer’s Project Act (42 U.S.C. 11225(g)) is amend-
14 ed—

15 (1) in paragraph (1)—

16 (A) by striking “that includes an evalua-
17 tion” and inserting the following: “that in-
18 cludes—

19 “(A) an evaluation”;

20 (B) in subparagraph (A) (as so des-
21 ignated), by adding “and” at the end; and

22 (C) by adding at the end the following:

23 “(B) a summary of the Secretary’s process
24 for identifying and updating what conditions
25 constitute Alzheimer’s disease;” and

1 (2) in paragraph (3)(A)(ii), by inserting “and
2 reduce disparities” before the semicolon at the end.

3 (e) SUNSET.—Section 2(h) of the National Alz-
4 heimer’s Project Act (42 U.S.C. 11225(h)) is amended by
5 striking “2025” and inserting “2035”.
