AND COMMUNITY-BASED SERVICES UNDER
MEDICAID.

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1924(h)(1)(A) of the So-7 cial Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1396r-5(h)(1)(A)) is amended by striking "(at the option of the State) is described 8 in section 1902(a)(10)(A)(ii)(VI)" and inserting the fol-9 lowing: "is eligible for medical assistance for home and 10 community-based services provided under subsection (c), 11 (d), or (i) of section 1915, under a waiver approved under 12 13 section 1115, or who is eligible for such medical assistance by reason of being determined eligible under section 14 1902(a)(10)(C) or by reason of section 1902(f) or other-15 wise on the basis of a reduction of income based on costs 16 incurred for medical or other remedial care, or who is eligi-17 ble for medical assistance for home and community-based 18 19 attendant services and supports under section 1915(k)". 20 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Section 2404 of the 21 Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (42 U.S.C. 22 1396r–5 note) is amended by striking "September 30, 2027" and inserting "the date of enactment of the 23 Act of 2024". 24
