3 SECTION 1. ENSURING THE RELIABILITY OF ADDRESS IN-

4 FORMATION PROVIDED UNDER THE MED-5 ICAID PROGRAM.

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1902(a) of the Social Se-

7 curity Act (42 U.S.C. 1396a(a)) is amended—

1 (1) in paragraph (86), by striking "and" at the 2 end;

3 (2) in paragraph (87), by striking the period at
4 the end and inserting "; and"; and

5 (3) by inserting after paragraph (87) the fol-6 lowing new paragraph:

"(88) beginning January 1, 2026, provide for a 7 8 process to regularly obtain address information for 9 individuals enrolled under such plan (or a waiver of 10 such plan) from reliable data sources (as described 11 in section 435.919 of title 42, Code of Federal Reg-12 ulations (or a successor regulation)) and act on any 13 changes to such an address based on such informa-14 tion in accordance with such section (or successor 15 regulation).".

(b) ENSURING TRANSMISSION OF ADDRESS INFORMATION FROM MANAGED CARE ORGANIZATIONS.—Section 1932 of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1396u2) is amended by adding at the end the following new subsection:

"(j) TRANSMISSION OF ADDRESS INFORMATION.—
Beginning January 1, 2026, each contract under a State
plan with a managed care entity under section 1903(m)
shall provide that the entity transmits to the State any
address information for an individual enrolled with the en-

- 1 tity that is provided to such entity directly from, or
- 2 verified by such entity directly with, such individual.".
