

DISH Broadband L.L.C., a subsidiary of DISH Network, L.L.C., entered into a Broadband Initiatives Program Grant Agreement (the "Agreement") dated September 24, 2010 with the Rural Utilities Service for a grant of up to \$14,159,250 to provide broadband service to consumers in certain unserved areas.
