## **John D. Burke, Board Member, Vermont Public Service Board**

John D. Burke has been a member of the Vermont Public Service Board since January 2001. He is a member of NARUC and currently serves as chair of the Telecommunications Committee. He is a state member of the Universal Services Joint Board and is state chair of the Separations Joint Board. Burke has been an adjunct professor of Business Law at Castleton State College for 25 years and still practices law in his home town of Castleton, VT. Burke also has served on the Rutland County Bar Association, Family Court Committee and Real Property Committee, as well as on the VBA Municipal Law Committee. He served as a director of the Vermont Municipal Bond Bank for several years, before resigning in 2001 when appointed to the Public Service Board. Burke earned an A.B. in Religious Philosophy from Dartmouth College and a J.D. from Boston University School of Law.
