

Chad is CEO of Etsy, leading the company in its mission and growing it into a global community of creative entrepreneurs and their customers. Under Chad's leadership, marketplace sales by Etsy's community of more than a million sellers have grown significantly. The company became a Certified B Corporation in 2012 and, in both 2013 and 2014, Etsy was named one of the Best Small & Medium Workplaces by the Great Place to Work® Institute. Prior to becoming CEO in 2011, Chad was Etsy's CTO.

Before joining Etsy, Chad led Yahoo's Brickhouse & Advanced products team, and the Yahoo! Developer Network. Notably, he created the Yahoo! Hack Day initiative, the first internal innovation program of its kind.
