Jon currently serves as the Managing Director at the Federal Communications Commission, where he leads the FCC's management operations including budget, human resources, information technology, contracting, and performance management. He also oversees the management and operations of the Universal Service Administrative Company, the administrator of the Universal Service Fund, which supports over \$8 billion annually in advanced telecommunications services for the nation's schools and libraries; low income individuals; and rural communities.

Jon joined the FCC in November 2013. Prior to that, Jon spent 16 years at McKinsey & Company's Washington, DC office where he worked with large private and government sector clients in the telecommunications, media, and public sector practice areas. He also served as a policy advisor in the Office of Plans and Policy at the FCC in from 1998-1999, and as a federal judicial law clerk from 1995-1996.
