**BILL:**     **Discussion Draft**, the “Federal Communications Commission Reform Act of 2015”

**AMENDMENT:**     An amendment offered by Mr. Yarmuth, No. 3, To require the Federal Communications Commission to revise its sponsorship identification rule (section 73.1212 and 76.1615 of title 47, Code of Federal Regulations) so as to provide that, in the case of broadcast matter or origination cablecasting matter that is political matter or matter involving the discussion of a controversial issue of public importance, the announcement required by such sections shall include the names of significant donors to the person the identity of which is required to be disclosed in such announcement.

**DISPOSITION:**     **NOT AGREED TO**, by a roll call vote of 13 yeas and 17 nays.
