Christopher Shelton was elected President of the Communications Workers of America by acclamation by delegates to the union's 75th convention on June 8, 2015.

Since 2005, he had been Vice President of CWA District 1, representing 160,000 members in more than 300 CWA locals in New Jersey, New York, and England.

Prior to his election as Vice President, Shelton was
Assistant to the District 1 Vice President, responsible for contract negotiations
