BOYCOM Cablevision, Inc., is a family-owned, incumbent multiple system operator (MSO) that provides video, telephone and high speed broadband internet service in rural portions of Butler, Wayne, Stoddard, Carter and Ripley counties in southeast Missouri.

BOYCOM currently provides high-speed broadband internet service to approximately 3,000 customers as well as video services to approximately 2,000 customers in communities within Butler, Wayne, Stoddard, Carter and Ripley counties in southeastern Missouri as a “last-mile” internet service provider. BOYCOM launched a telephone produce in 2011 in Butler County and is currently deploying in Wayne as well.

BOYCOM was founded in 1992 by Steven D. and Patricia Jo Boyers after 15 years in the underground telecommunication construction business. BOYCOM Cablevision built its first system in Butler County, MO, in the rural areas surrounding the community of Poplar Bluff. They went on to build a cable network in the Lake Wappapello area of Butler and Wayne Counties. Additional cable networks have been added to its operations over the years by purchasing systems in surrounding communities as they have become available.

BOYCOM Cablevision employs 27 and continues to grow and expand its business by working diligently to bring advanced broadband to the communities we serve.
