

**AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE
TO H.R. 2501
OFFERED BY MR. MICHAEL F. DOYLE OF
PENNSYLVANIA AND MR. GUS BILIRAKIS OF FLORIDA**

Strike all after the enacting clause and insert the following:

1 SEC. 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the “Spectrum Coordination
3 Act”.

**4 SEC. 2. UPDATE OF MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
5 ON SPECTRUM COORDINATION BETWEEN
6 NTIA AND FCC.**

7 Not later than December 31, 2022, the National
8 Telecommunications and Information Administration and
9 the Federal Communications Commission shall update the
10 Memorandum of Understanding on Spectrum Coordina-
11 tion entered into in January 2003, to—

12 (1) improve upon the process for resolving fre-
13 quency allocation disputes in shared or adjacent allo-
14 cations between the National Telecommunications
15 and Information Administration and the Federal
16 Communications Commission to ensure that such

1 disputes are definitively resolved in an efficient and
2 timely manner;

3 (2) ensure that spectrum is used efficiently; and

4 (3) establish reasonable timelines for the ex-
5 change of information between the National Tele-
6 communications and Information Administration
7 and the Federal Communications Commission in
8 order to maintain effective spectrum coordination
9 and collaboration.
