## SUBCOMMITTEE ON COMMUNICATIONS AND TECHNOLOGY Hybrid Markup

The Subcommittee on Communications and Technology of the Committee on Energy and Commerce met, pursuant to notice, at 10:31 a.m., a quorum being present, for a hybrid markup in the John D. Dingell Room, 2123 of the Rayburn House Office Building, as well as remotely via the Committee's WebEx platform, Hon. Mike Doyle (Chairman of the subcommittee) presiding. The business before the Subcommittee was consideration and markup of two bills. The following actions were taken:

1. <u>H.R. 1218</u>, the "Data Mapping to Save Moms' Lives Act", was ordered reported favorably to the full Committee, **amended**, by a voice vote (**Final Passage**).

The following amendments were offered during consideration of H.R. 1218:

- An Amendment in the nature of a substitute (AINS) #1 (H1218\_ANS\_01), offered by Mr. Butterfield, was agreed to by a voice vote.
- 2. <u>H.R. 2501</u>, the "Spectrum Coordination Act", was ordered reported favorably to the full Committee, **amended**, by a voice vote. (**Final Passage**).

The following amendments were offered during consideration of H.R. 2501:

• An Amendment in the nature of a substitute (AINS) #1 (<u>SLW\_1119</u>), offered by Mr. Doyle, was agreed to by a voice vote.
