A steel industry veteran, Michael G. Rippey serves as president and chief executive officer of ArcelorMittal USA. ArcelorMittal USA is a vital component of the company's global footprint and employs approximately 16,000 people with operations in 7 states.

In this role, Rippey manages the USA leadership team and business functions such as finance, procurement, sales and marketing, and human resources. When the company merged to create ArcelorMittal in mid-2007, Rippey provided critical leadership to integrate U.S. facilities including flat and plate steel operations.

Prior to August 2006, he held roles as executive vice president, sales and marketing with direct responsibility for light, flat-rolled and plate products and also as executive vice president, commercial, and chief financial officer, at Ispat Inland, a predecessor company.

A valued member of the senior leadership team since 1998, Rippey began his career with Inland Steel in 1984. He holds a bachelors of marketing from Indiana University, a masters of banking and finance from Loyola University, Chicago, and a masters of business administration from the University of Chicago.

Rippey is involved in the Chicagoland and Northwest Indiana communities. He serves on the Board of Directors for the Chicagoland Chamber of Commerce and Metal Service Center Institute. A proud Indiana University alumni, Rippey is part of the Kelly School of Business' Dean's Council. He also supports Children's Home + Aid as a Governing Trustee and member of the Finance & Audit Committee.
