John Mulligan is chief financial officer and executive vice president for Target, the second largest general merchandise retailer in the U.S. His responsibilities include treasury, internal and external financial reporting, financial planning and analysis, financial operations, tax, assurance, investor relations and flight services.

Mulligan joined Target in 1996 as a financial analyst, and during his tenure has held key leadership positions in Finance, Target.com and Human Resources.

In 2003, he was promoted to director, Target.com Finance, and in 2005 was named director, Capital Investments. Mulligan was promoted to vice president, Financial Planning and Analysis, in 2006, and was named vice president, Pay and Benefits, in 2007. In 2010, he was named senior vice president, Treasury and Accounting, leading accounting and financial operations, including India, in addition to all Treasury functions.

In addition to his Target responsibilities, Mulligan also serves on the Finance Committee for Habitat for Humanity, and the University of Wisconsin Business School Dean's Advisory Board.

Mulligan graduated from the University of Wisconsin in 1988, and in 1996 he earned a masters of business administration degree from the University of Minnesota.
