Rick Schostek is executive vice president of Honda North America, Inc., with responsibility for the following strategic planning, support, and governance functions: Regional Planning, Finance, HR & Administration, Information Services, Government & Industry Relations, Corporate Communications, the Office of Inclusion & Diversity, Law, Corporate Audit and Manufacturing Operations Audit. Schostek is also a member of the North American Regional Operating Board and is the company's Risk Management Officer.

Prior to this, Schostek was senior vice president of Honda North America, Inc., and Honda North America Services, LLC.

Schostek joined Honda in 1987 as an attorney in the Legal Department, concentrating in commercial and environmental areas. He was named general counsel and assistant vice president of the Legal Department and Corporate Affairs in 1998. In 2001, he was promoted to vice president and given additional responsibilities over the support services area.

In 2004, Schostek joined Honda Manufacturing of Alabama where he provided overall operational leadership at this facility.

He joined Honda Manufacturing of Indiana in 2008 to take a leadership role in the start-up of Honda's newest auto manufacturing plant in North America. In 2011, he returned to Honda in Ohio and was promoted to senior vice president in 2012.

In addition to his role at Honda North America, Schostek is a member of the board of directors of the Ohio Manufacturers' Association and the National Association of Manufacturers. He also serves on the Ohio State University College of Engineering's External Advisory Council.
