

 - b. Takata is currently contracted for this study by NHTSA Vehicle Safety Research group.
 - c. Contract executed 9/27/2012 still in process, estimated completion 6/30/2015
 - d. Total funding from NHTSA: \$1,886,904

- (2) The DADSS Project – alcohol detection system for cars
 - a. There have been two phases. We are currently in the second phase.
