- To amend title 49, United States Code, to require the establishment of a national database of vehicle identification numbers and other information to facilitate notification of motor vehicle-related recalls.
 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Improving Recall5 Tracking Act".

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1SEC. 2. NATIONAL VEHICLE IDENTIFICATION NUMBER2DATABASE.

3 301 of title 49, United States Code, is amended by4 adding after section 30119 the following new section:

5 "§ 30119A. National vehicle identification number6 database

7 "(a) ESTABLISHMENT.—Not later than 2 years after 8 the date of enactment of the Improving Recall Tracking 9 Act, the Secretary shall complete the establishment of a 10 national database of vehicle identification numbers and 11 other information provided by States in accordance with 12 subsection (b).

13 "(b) STATES REQUIRED TO PROVIDE VIN AND VE-14 HICLE REGISTRATION INFORMATION.—

15 "(1) IN GENERAL.—Each State shall provide to
16 the Secretary, in such manner as determined by the
17 Secretary, the vehicle identification number of each
18 motor vehicle registered in the State, and shall also
19 provide, associated with such vehicle identification
20 number—

21 "(A) the make, model, and year of manu-22 facturer of the motor vehicle; and

"(B) the name and address of the person to whom the vehicle is registered, and an email address for such person if such person provides an email address.

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"(2) TIMETABLE.—Each State shall begin to
provide the Secretary with the information required
under paragraph (1) on the date determined by the
Secretary and shall provide such information for all
motor vehicles registered in the State not later than
2 years after the date of enactment of the Improving
Recall Tracking Act.

"(3) UPDATING OF INFORMATION.—Each State 8 9 shall verify that the information provided to the Sec-10 retary under to paragraph (1) is current each time 11 a motor vehicle is subsequently registered in the 12 State and shall provide any updated information to 13 the Secretary not later than 7 days after each such 14 subsequent registration when a change has occurred. 15 "(c) Access to Information by Manufacturers IN THE EVENT OF A RECALL.—In order to facilitate noti-16 17 fication of a defect or noncompliance under section 30119, an entity required to send notification under such section 18 19 may submit to the Secretary a request containing the vehi-20 cle identification numbers of the vehicles containing a de-21 fect or noncompliance. Upon receiving such a request, the 22 Secretary shall, within 2 business days, provide the entity 23 the names and addresses of the persons to whom such ve-24 hicles are registered, and the email addresses for such persons who have provided an email address. 25

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1 "(d) INFORMATION SECURITY AND LIMITATION ON 2 USE.—The Secretary shall establish and maintain reasonable security measures for the information submitted to 3 and released from the database established under this sec-4 5 tion. Neither the Secretary nor any entity obtaining information from the Secretary shall disclose information con-6 7 tained in the database for any other purpose than pro-8 viding the required notification to consumers about a de-9 fect or noncompliance.

10 "(e) Updating Existing Public Website.—Not later than 2 years after the date of enactment of the Im-11 proving Recall Tracking Act, the Secretary shall update 12 the public website, www.safercar.gov, established pursuant 13 to section 31301 of the Moving Ahead for Progress in the 14 15 21st Century Act (49 U.S.C. 30166 note), to permit the searching and processing for multiple vehicle identification 16 numbers in a single search request. 17

18 "(f) CONTRACTED ENTITIES.—Nothing in the section 19 shall be construed to prohibit the Secretary from engaging 20 an outside contractor for the establishment and mainte-21 nance of the database required by this section if the Sec-22 retary determines that such contractor adheres to appro-23 priate and reasonable security measures described in sub-24 section (d). "(g) FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT EXEMP TION.—Information contained in the national vehicle iden tification number database established under this section
 shall be exempt from public disclosure under section
 552(b) of title 5, Unites States Code.".
