A BILL

To amend the Federal Trade Commission Act to require the Federal Trade Commission to publish on the website of the Commission documents to be voted on by the Commission, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Federal Trade Com-
- 5 mission Transparency Act".

SEC. 2. PUBLICATION OF DOCUMENTS IN ADVANCE OF FTC 2 VOTING. 3 (a) AMENDMENT.—Section 18 of the Federal Trade Commission Act (15 U.S.C. 57a) is amended by inserting 4 5 at the end the following new subsection: 6 "(k)(1) The Commission may not adopt any order, 7 decision, report, or action by vote of the Commission at a meeting of the Commission, unless the Chairman causes 8 9 to be published on the website of the Commission the text of such order, decision, report, or action not later than 10 11 30 days before the date on which the vote is to occur, except when the Chairman determines that emergency or 12 other exigent circumstances require publication less than 13 14 30 days before the date on which the vote is to occur. "(2) The text published pursuant to paragraph 15 16 (1) shall be the text intended at the time of the pub-17 lishing to be subject to a vote. Nothing in this sub-18 section may be construed to prevent the Commission 19 from making changes to the text after the pub-20 lishing. 21 "(3) If the Chairman determines that publica-22 tion of all or a portion of an order, decision, report, 23 or action is likely to lead to a result described in a 24 paragraph of section 552b(c) of title 5, United 25 States Code, the Chairman may exempt such order,

decision, report, or action, or such portion, as the

4	"(A) create any rights or remedies; or					
5	"(B) provide a basis for challenging any

8	(b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by					
9	this section shall apply beginning on the date that is 90					
10	days after the date of the enactment of this Act.
