Assistant Special Agent in Charge Mike Duffey is a graduate of Florida State University with a degree in Criminology. He began his law enforcement career 25 years ago with the Tallahassee Police Department (TPD) as a patrol officer then eventually moving to the street crimes unit working primarily with street narcotic sales. During his tenure at the Tallahassee Police Department, Officer Duffey was an instructor with the International Police Mountain Bike Association and a member of Tallahassee Police Department Community Orienting Policing (COP Squad) which focused on street narcotics sales.

In 2000, Special Agent Duffey accepted a position with the Florida Department of Insurance, Division of Insurance Fraud as a State sworn Insurance Fraud Investigator. Agent Duffey investigated insurance fraud involving medical providers, fraudulent claims, insurance agents and Viatical Fraud.

In 2003, Special Agent Duffey joined FDLE in the Computer Crime Center. Since joining the Computer Crime Center in 2003 Agent Duffey has been involved in computer crime cases that involved fugitives, gangs, domestic security, homicides, fraud, network intrusions, BOT Networks and Internet Crimes Against Children investigations.

In 2013, Special Agent Duffey promoted to Special Agent Supervisor and assumed the role of Cyber High Tech Statewide Coordinator. In this role Special Agent Supervisor Duffey helped develop and implement FDLE's regional expansion into combating cyber-crime along, FDLE wiretap program, development of FDLE's Intrusion teams along with the continued development of FDLE's Electronic Surveillance Support team's around the State.

In 2019, Special Agent Supervisor Duffey was promoted to Assistant Special Agent in charge of FDLE's Office of Statewide Investigations, which includes FDLE Aviation, Mutual Aid, Cyber High-Tech Crime units.
