

AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE
TO H.R. 5360
OFFERED BY MRS. HOUCHIN OF INDIANA

Strike all after the enacting clause and insert the following:

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the “AI Warnings And Re-
3 sources for Education Act” or the “AWARE Act”.

4 SEC. 2. AI CHATBOTS AND MINORS.

5 (a) EDUCATIONAL RESOURCES.—Not later than 1
6 year after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Com-
7 mission, in consultation with relevant Federal agencies,
8 shall develop and make available to the public educational
9 resources for parents, educators, and minors with respect
10 to the safe and responsible use of AI chatbots by minors.

11 (b) CONTENTS.—The educational resources devel-
12 oped and made available under subsection (a) shall include
13 resources on—

- 14 (1) the risks and benefits of AI chatbot use;
15 (2) privacy and data collection practices; and
16 (3) best practices for parents supporting the
17 safe use of AI chatbots by minors.

1 (c) YOVILLE.—The Commission shall, in a manner
2 appropriate for minors, model the educational resources
3 developed and made available under subsection (a) on the
4 Yoville program of the Commission.

5 (d) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

6 (1) ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE.—The term “ar-
7 tificial intelligence” has the meaning given such
8 term in section 5002 of the National Artificial Intel-
9 ligence Initiative Act of 2020 (15 U.S.C. 9401).

10 (2) AI CHATBOT.—The term “AI chatbot”
11 means an artificial intelligence system, marketed to
12 and available for use by consumers, that engages in
13 interactive, natural-language communication with a
14 user and generates or selects content in response to
15 user inputs (including text, voice, or other inputs)
16 using a conversational context.

17 (3) COMMISSION.—The term “Commission”
18 means the Federal Trade Commission.

19 (4) MINOR.—The term “minor” means an indi-
20 vidual under the age of 17 years.

21 (5) PARENT.—The term “parent” includes a
22 legal guardian of a minor.
