Caitriona (KUH-TREE-nuh) Fitzgerald is Deputy Director and Policy Director at the Electronic Privacy Information Center (EPIC), a non-profit research and advocacy center dedicated to securing the fundamental right to privacy in the digital age for all people.

Caitriona leads the development of EPIC's policy agenda. She provides expertise to policymakers at both the state and federal level to advance strong privacy, platform governance, and AI oversight laws. Caitriona has testified before Congress and dozens of state legislatures.

Prior to joining EPIC in 2015, Ms. Fitzgerald served as Chief of Staff to Massachusetts State Senator Barry Finegold.

Caitriona served as a Harvard Law School Wasserstein Fellow in 2023 and was awarded the Information Policy Award by Public Knowledge in 2024.

Caitriona holds a J.D. from Northeastern University School of Law and a B.A. in Computer Science from the State University of New York at Geneseo.
