**Momentive Specialty Chemicals Inc., formerly, Hexion Specialty Chemicals, Inc. ("MSC"):**

A contract between MSC and BAE Systems Ordnance Systems Inc. ("BAE") (Holston Army Ammunition Plant) was entered into on January 1, 2009 for the sale of a certain chemical substance to BAE. The fixed term ended December 31, 2011, and currently any sales are "at will".

**Momentive Performance Materials Inc. ("MPM")**

Momentive Performance Materials Inc. had an agreement with the Dept. of Energy's Advanced Research Projects Agency - Energy (ARPA-E) effective as of January 15, 2010, but this agreement was assigned to Soraa, Inc. effective as of June 6, 2012 after ARPA-E selected Soraa to continue with program development.

**Other Agreement:**

A Cooperative Agreement between Momentive Performance Materials Quartz, Inc. and the US Army Research Laboratory was established for work to be completed over the course of up to 60 months (five years), starting October 1, 2010. Since that time two funding allotments have been made as part of separate Contract Line Item Numbers (CLINs). MPM is currently working with ARL on a 3<sup>rd</sup>.

**A. CLIN 0001:**

**Purpose:** Development of lightweight, large format fused silica-based transparent armor

**Original Period of Performance:** April 6, 2011 to April 5, 2013; later extended at no cost to the government to April 5, 2014 as part of Contract Modification P0002.

**B. CLIN 0002 (2<sup>nd</sup> Program Plan):**

**Purpose:** Additional tasks related to Army and Navy effort toward "flawless glass"

**Period of Performance:** February 11, 2013 to February 10, 2014

**C. CLIN 0003 (pending, 3<sup>rd</sup> Program Plan):** \$275,000

Additional tasks related to Army and Navy effort toward "flawless glass"

**Period of Performance (anticipated)** October 1, 2013 to September 30<sup>th</sup>, 2014


