Scott Slesinger Biography

Scott Slesinger is the Legislative Director of the Natural Resources Defense Council (NRDC). He directs NRDC's federal lobbying efforts on many environmental issues, including toxics, wildlife, oceans, NEPA, and appropriations. He is NRDC's lead representative on coal ash and regulatory reform and serves on the board of the Blue-Green Alliance, the Coalition for Sensible Safeguards and the steering committee of the Non-Defense Discretionary Coalition.

Slesinger began his career in the personal office of Rep. Henry Nowak (D-NY) and moved to the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) to work on water and oceans issues. His varied career included committee work on the Public Works and Transportation Committee and working for Senator Frank Lautenberg as well as time at the National Association of Home Builders and 12 years representing the hazardous waste disposal industry. In that capacity, he promoted electronic manifests to replace paper for the tracking of hazardous waste shipments.

He received his BA and Juris Doctor from the University at Buffalo.
