

Curriculum Vitae

Leigh Ing is the Executive Director of the Texas Low-Level Radioactive Waste Disposal Compact Commission. She began in May 2012 when the Compact Facility in Andrews, Texas opened for disposal of low-level radioactive waste. Ms. Ing has 25 years of experience working in environmental programs within the State of Texas. She was formerly the Deputy Director of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality overseeing state implementation of the Clean Water Act, the Clean Air Act, the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act as well as Superfund, the Safe Drinking Water Act and the licensing of the Texas Low-Level Radioactive Waste Disposal Authority. In this capacity, she worked within delegation and agreement programs with the US Environmental Protection Agency and the Nuclear Regulatory Commission. She has also assisted private entities, associations and members of the public in developing and understanding environmental regulations, permitting and licensing. Ms. Ing has a Bachelor of Science in Civil Engineering and a Master of Science in Environmental Health Engineering both from the University of Texas at Austin.
