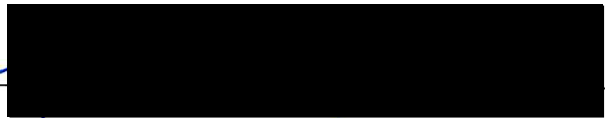

J. Meade R. Anderson, CPG is the chairperson of the ASTSWMO Brownfields Focus Group and has been involved in brownfields issues for 14 years. Meade is the Manager of the Brownfields & Voluntary Remediation Programs at the Virginia Department of Environmental Quality and has been employed there for almost 27 years. He has extensive experience with environmental remediation and innovative problem solving on a wide range of sites.

He also worked for five years in the private sector with a large environmental and engineering consulting firm with projects on the east coast and for over two years with the United States Geological Survey working on various water related and environmental projects.
