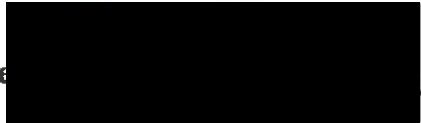

Sean Alteri, Director, Kentucky Division for Air Quality
