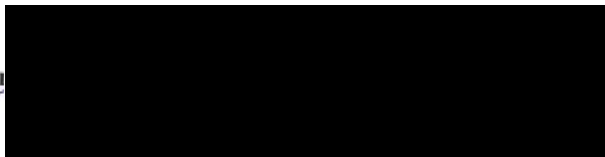

J. Meade R. Anderson, CPG is the chairperson of the ASTSWMO Brownfields Focus Group and has been involved in brownfields issues for 16 years. Meade is the Manager of the Brownfields & Voluntary Remediation Programs at the Virginia Department of Environmental Quality and has been employed by DEQ for nearly 28 years. He has extensive experience with environmental remediation and innovative problem solving on a wide range of sites.

He also worked for five years in the private sector with a large environmental and engineering consulting firm with projects on the east coast and for over two years with the United States Geological Survey working on various water related and environmental projects.

Meade is a Certified Professional Geologist and has served for twelve years under four governors on the Virginia Board for Geology performing as Chairperson for six years.
