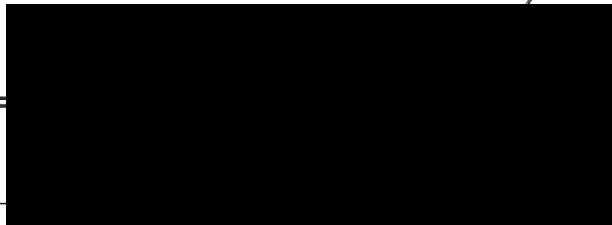

Overview:

Martin A. Kropelnicki is the President & Chief Executive Officer of California Water Service Group, the third-largest publicly traded water and wastewater utility in the United States. The company's purpose is to improve the quality of life for customers, communities, employees, and stockholders. It dates back to 1926, when its largest subsidiary was formed to provide water service to a handful of communities in California; today it serves two million people in California, Washington, Hawaii, and New Mexico.

Professional Experience:

Kropelnicki joined California Water Service Group as Vice President, Chief Financial Officer, and Treasurer in 2006. He was named President and Chief Operating Officer in 2012 and President and Chief Executive Officer in 2013. He has more than 27 years of experience in finance and operations, including more than 15 years as chief financial officer at publicly listed companies, and has held executive positions at PowerLight Corporation, Hall Kinion & Associates, Deloitte & Touche Consulting Group, and Pacific Gas & Electric Company.

Education:

Kropelnicki holds a Bachelor of Arts Degree and Master of Arts Degree in Business Economics from San Jose State University.

Honors and Awards:

San Jose State University named Kropelnicki Graduate of the Decade in 2002 and Alumni of the Year in 2005 and 2010. Larkin Street Youth Services and the San Francisco Business Times named him Bay Area CFO of the Year in 2009. Recipient of the 2016 Naval Heritage Award.
