Vince Brisini is the Director of Environmental Affairs for Olympus Power, LLC. In that role he manages the environmental issues associated with their various electric generating assets.

Previously, he served as the Deputy Secretary for the Office of Waste, Air, Radiation and Remediation at the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection. As Deputy Secretary, Mr. Brisini oversaw the bureaus of Waste Management, Air Quality, Radiation Protection and Environmental Cleanup and Brownfields (Remediation).

Prior to his appointment as Deputy Secretary, Mr. Brisini worked 33 years in the electric generating business. His roles included management of all air quality matters including regulatory analysis, policy advocacy, emissions trading policies and strategies as well as technical issues.

He has acted in an advisory capacity to U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, the Ozone Transport Commission and also to the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (PADEP). Mr. Brisini has served as a member of various committees such as the Acid Rain Advisory Committee/NO_x Subcommittee, the Clean Air Act Advisory Committee and various workgroups, the FACA committee for Ozone, Particulate Matter and Regional Haze, the PADEP Mercury Rule Workgroup and PADEP Air Quality Technical Advisory Committee.
