Amendment to H.R. 350 Offered by Mrs. Dingell of Michigan

Strike sections 3, 4, and 5 and insert the following:

SEC. 3. EXEMPTION OF VEHICLES USED SOLELY FOR COM PETITION FROM THE ANTI-TAMPERING PRO VISIONS OF THE CLEAN AIR ACT.

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 203 of the Clean Air Act 5 (42 U.S.C. 7522) is amended by adding at the end of subsection (a) the following: "No action with respect to any 6 7 device or element of design referred to in paragraph (3) shall be treated as a prohibited act under that paragraph 8 9 if the action is for the purpose of modifying a motor vehicle that is not registered to be operated on a street or 10 11 highway and is to be used solely for competition.".

12 (b) IMPLEMENTATION.—Not later than two years 13 after the date of enactment of this Act, the Administrator 14 of the Environmental Protection Agency shall promulgate 15 final regulations as necessary to implement the amend-16 ment made by subsection (a).
