

Geoffrey H. Fettus, a Senior Attorney at the Natural Resources Defense Council, litigates in federal courts and testifies before Congress on the beginning and end of the nuclear fuel cycle. Key cases include the "Waste Confidence" victory over the Nuclear Regulatory Commission in the United States Court of Appeals for the D.C.
