A BILL

To require the Administrator of the Environmental Protection Agency to revise the Safer Choice Standard to provide for a Safer Choice label for pots, pans, and cooking utensils that do not contain PFAS, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SAFER CHOICE LABEL FOR POTS, PANS, AND**
4 **COOKING UTENSILS.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 1 year after the
6 date of enactment of this Act, the Administrator of the
7 Environmental Protection Agency shall revise the Safer

1 Choice Standard of the Safer Choice Program to identify
2 the requirements for a pot, pan, or cooking utensil to meet
3 in order to be labeled with a Safer Choice label, including
4 a requirement that any such pot, pan, or cooking utensil
5 does not contain any PFAS.

6 (b) DEFINITION.—In this Act, the term “PFAS”
7 means a perfluoroalkyl or polyfluoroalkyl substance with
8 at least one fully fluorinated carbon atom.

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
