Mr. Fjeld-Hansen is the Vice President of Musket and Trillium for the Love's Family of Companies. In this role, Mr. Fjeld-Hansen oversees all diesel, gasoline, and alternative fuel procurement and marketing for Love's Travel Stops & Country Stores. In addition, Mr. Fjeld-Hansen has directed the company's biofuels blending, DEF supply, and crude oil marketing businesses since their inception.

Mr. Fjeld-Hansen also launched the company's CNG business, and oversaw the 2016 acquisition and rebranding of Trillium. Trillium is now the 2nd largest CNG vehicle fuel provider in the US, one of the largest RNG suppliers in the Country, and an active developer of Hydrogen, EV, and other alternative energy/fuel projects.

Mr. Fjeld-Hansen has worked for Love's since 2007. Prior to Love's, Mr. Fjeld-Hansen held various management and trading roles at Saracen Energy, the Williams Companies, and Phibro Energy. Mr. Fjeld-Hansen is a graduate of the University of Texas at Austin, and completed officer training for the Norwegian Navy.
