Chet Thompson is President and CEO of the American Fuel & Petrochemical Manufacturers (AFPM), the trade association representing the makers of the fuels that keep us moving, the petrochemicals that are the essential building blocks for modern life, and the midstream companies that get our feedstocks and products where they need to go. He became AFPM's president and CEO in 2015.

Prior to joining AFPM, Thompson was a partner at Crowell & Moring LLP, where he was chairman of the Environment & Natural Resources Group. He previously served as deputy general counsel at the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) during the George W. Bush Administration. Before joining EPA in 2004, he spent 10 years at Collier Shannon Scott PLLC.

Since joining AFPM, Thompson has been appointed to the U.S. Chamber's Association Committee of 100, which is committed to advancing jobs, growth and opportunity that help our nation prosper, and he was invited to join The Economic Club of Washington, D.C., which serves to promote a greater sense of community among the region's top business and government leaders. He has been named by The Hill as one of Washington's Top Lobbyists every year since joining AFPM in 2015.
