

**AMENDMENT TO THE AMENDMENT IN THE  
NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE TO H.R. 9624  
OFFERED BY MR. CASTRO OF TEXAS**

At the appropriate place, insert the following new section:

6 (a) REVIEW.—Not later than 180 days after the date  
7 of the enactment of this Act, the Inspector General of the  
8 Intelligence Community shall submit to the congressional  
9 intelligence committees a review of the analytic integrity  
10 of each covered intelligence product.

11 (b) MATTERS INCLUDED.—The review under sub-  
12 section (a) shall include the following:

13 (1) A description of any instance in which an  
14 officer or employee of the Federal Government di-  
15 rected, requested, encouraged, or attempted to influ-  
16 ence the modification of the analytic judgments, dis-  
17 semination, timing of dissemination, or classification  
18 status of a covered intelligence product, and an eval-

1       uation of whether any such instance was inconsistent  
2       with the standards required by law.

3           (2) A description of any personnel action taken  
4       on or after February 1, 2025, with respect to any  
5       officer or employee of the Office of the Director of  
6       National Intelligence involved in the production or  
7       review of a covered intelligence product, and an eval-  
8       uation of whether any such action was taken in re-  
9       sponse to the substance of the analytic judgments  
10      contained in a covered intelligence product.

11          (3) An evaluation of whether public statements  
12      made by officials of elements of the intelligence com-  
13      munity regarding the subject matter of the covered  
14      intelligence products accurately characterized the  
15      analytic judgments of the intelligence community.

16      (c) COVERED INTELLIGENCE PRODUCT DEFINED.—  
17   In this section, the term “covered intelligence product”  
18   means a finished intelligence product produced by an ele-  
19   ment of the intelligence community during the five-year  
20   period preceding the date of the enactment of this Act re-  
21   garding the Government of the Bolivarian Republic of  
22   Venezuela and the transnational criminal organization  
23   known as Tren de Aragua.
