

**AMENDMENT TO THE AMENDMENT IN THE
NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE TO H.R. 9624
OFFERED BY M__ . _____**

At the appropriate place, insert the following new
section:

1 **SEC. ____ . INSPECTOR GENERAL OF THE INTELLIGENCE**
2 **COMMUNITY REVIEW AND AUDIT OF THE**
3 **CENTRAL INTELLIGENCE AGENCY'S SECU-**
4 **RITY, INSIDER THREAT, COUNTERINTEL-**
5 **LIGENCE, AND COUNTERESPIONAGE PRO-**
6 **GRAMS.**

7 (a) REVIEW REQUIRED.—The Inspector General of
8 the Intelligence Community shall conduct a comprehensive
9 review of the activities of the security, insider threat, coun-
10 terintelligence, and counterespionage programs of the
11 Central Intelligence Agency to examine the efficacy of
12 those programs and the compliance of those programs
13 with all applicable laws, executive orders, regulations, poli-
14 cies, and governance frameworks during the period from
15 calendar year 2018 through calendar year 2026.

16 (b) PROGRAMS EXAMINED.—The review under sub-
17 section (a) shall include an examination of—

1 (1) the programs of the Office of Security, the
2 Counterintelligence Mission Center, and the Coun-
3 terespionage Group;

4 (2) the Insider Threat Program; and

5 (3) any other program of the Central Intel-
6 ligence Agency that focuses on the risks posed by
7 current or former—

8 (A) officers or employees of the Central In-
9 telligence Agency;

10 (B) employees of contractors of the Cen-
11 tral Intelligence Agency;

12 (C) persons or entities affiliated with ele-
13 ments of the intelligence community; or

14 (D) persons or entities with access to sys-
15 tems or facilities of the Central Intelligence
16 Agency.

17 (c) AUDIT.—The review under subsection (a) shall in-
18 clude a detailed audit of the use of insider threat authori-
19 ties, capabilities, and systems monitoring of information
20 systems owned or controlled by the Central Intelligence
21 Agency and used by intelligence community employees,
22 contractors, or affiliates.

23 (d) METHODS.—The Inspector General of the Intel-
24 ligence Community shall use all methods available to con-

1 duct the review, including the use of inspection, evalua-
2 tion, investigative, or other review methodologies.

3 (e) REPORTS TO COMMITTEES.—The Inspector Gen-
4 eral of the Intelligence Community shall submit to the con-
5 gressional intelligence committees—

6 (1) not later than 90 days after the date of the
7 enactment of this Act, an update on the progress
8 made in conducting the review; and

9 (2) not later than 270 days after the date of
10 the enactment of this Act, a final comprehensive report
11 on the results of the review, except as provided in
12 subsection (f).

13 (f) FINAL COMPREHENSIVE REPORT.—If the Inspec-
14 tor General of the Intelligence Community is not able to
15 submit a final comprehensive report within the period re-
16 quired by subsection (e)(2), the Inspector General shall
17 submit an interim report within the period required by
18 subsection (e)(2) and shall submit a final comprehensive
19 report as soon as practicable thereafter.
