

**AMENDMENT TO THE AMENDMENT IN THE
NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE TO H.R. 9624
OFFERED BY MR. AUSTIN SCOTT OF GEORGIA**

At the appropriate place, insert the following new section:

1 **SEC. ____ . ANNUAL LIST OF ORGANIZATIONS THAT ARE**
2 **PART OF THE UNITED FRONT SYSTEM OF**
3 **THE PEOPLE’S REPUBLIC OF CHINA.**

4 Section 1107 of the National Security Act of 1947
5 (50 U.S.C. 3237) is amended by adding at the end the
6 following new subsection:

7 “(d) ANNUAL LIST OF ORGANIZATIONS.—

8 “(1) REPORT.—On an annual basis, the Direc-
9 tor of National Intelligence shall submit to the con-
10 gressional intelligence committees and make avail-
11 able to covered recipients a report on organizations
12 that are associated with or receive funding from the
13 United Front Work Department, as described in
14 subsection (b)(2).

15 “(2) ELEMENTS.—Each report under para-
16 graph (1) shall include the following:

1 “(A) A list of each organization associated
2 with or that receives funding from the United
3 Front Work Department, including—

4 “(i) any entity subordinate to the
5 United Front Work Department;

6 “(ii) relevant governmental agencies
7 of the People’s Republic of China; and

8 “(iii) organizations participating in
9 the Chinese People’s Political Consultive
10 Conference.

11 “(B) An explanation that inclusion of an
12 organization on the list under subparagraph
13 (A)—

14 “(i) means there is a rebuttable pre-
15 sumption under paragraph (3)(A) that
16 such organization is an agent of a foreign
17 principal;

18 “(ii) does not presume any criminal
19 activity by the organization; and

20 “(iii) indicates such organization is af-
21 filiated with the influence and intelligence
22 structures of China.

23 “(3) EFFECTS OF INCLUSION.—

24 “(A) PRESUMPTION.—Inclusion of an or-
25 ganization on the list under paragraph (2)(A)

1 establishes a rebuttable presumption that the
2 organization is an agent of a foreign principal
3 for purposes of the Foreign Agents Registration
4 Act of 1938, as amended (22 U.S.C. 611 et
5 seq.).

6 “(B) CONSIDERATIONS.—The head of a
7 department or agency of the United States Gov-
8 ernment shall consider the inclusion of an orga-
9 nization on the list under paragraph (2)(A) in
10 determining any of the following:

11 “(i) Whether to impose any sanctions
12 against the organization.

13 “(ii) Whether to restrict any visas re-
14 lating to the organization.

15 “(iii) Whether to impose additional
16 disclosure requirements or other additional
17 vetting requirements on the organization.

18 “(4) REMOVAL FROM LIST.—An organization
19 included on a list under paragraph (2)(A) is pre-
20 sumed to be an agent of a foreign principal for pur-
21 poses of the Foreign Agents Registration Act of
22 1938, as amended (22 U.S.C. 611 et seq.) until the
23 Director of National Intelligence, in consultation
24 with the Attorney General, determines that such or-
25 ganization is no longer associated with or receiving

1 funding from the United Front Work Department
2 and acting as such an agent.

3 “(5) FORM.—Each report under paragraph (1)
4 shall be submitted in unclassified form, but may in-
5 clude a classified annex.

6 “(6) DEFINITION OF COVERED RECIPIENTS.—
7 In this subsection, the term ‘covered recipients’
8 means departments and agencies of the United
9 States Government, State governments, and local
10 governments, as determined appropriate by the Di-
11 rector of National Intelligence.”.
