MEMORANDUM

Subject: Full Committee Markup

On Wednesday, June 12, 2013, at 10:00 a.m. in 1324 Longworth House Office Building, the Committee on Natural Resources will hold a markup on the following bills:

- **H.R. 412**, To amend the Wild and Scenic Rivers Act to designate segments of the mainstem of the Nashua River and its tributaries in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts for study for potential addition to the National Wild and Scenic Rivers System, and for other purposes (*Nashua River Wild and Scenic River Study Act*).
- **H.R. 657**, To amend the Federal Land Policy and Management Act of 1976 to improve the management of grazing leases and permits, and for other purposes (*Grazing Improvement Act*).
- **H.R. 697**, To provide for the conveyance of certain Federal land in Clark County, Nevada, for the environmental remediation and reclamation of the Three Kids Mine Project Site, and for other purposes (*Three Kids Mine Remediation and Reclamation Act*).
- H.R. 740, To provide for the settlement of certain claims under the Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act, and for other purposes (*Southeast Alaska Native Land Entitlement Finalization and Jobs Protection Act*).
- **H.R. 841**, To amend the Grand Ronde Reservation Act to make technical corrections, and for other purposes.
- **H.R. 931,** To provide for the addition of certain real property to the reservation of the Siletz Tribe in the State of Oregon.
- **H.R. 1126**, To facilitate the completion of an appropriate national memorial to Dwight D. Eisenhower (*Dwight D. Eisenhower Memorial Completion Act*).
- **H.R. 1411**, To include the Point Arena-Stornetta Public Lands in the California Coastal National Monument as a part of the National Landscape Conservation System, and for other purposes (*California Coastal National Monument Expansion Act of 2013*).
- H.R. 1497, To amend title 36, United States Code, to ensure that memorials commemorating the service of the United States Armed Forces may contain religious symbols, and for other purposes (*War Memorial Protection Act*).
- **H.R. 1548**, To facilitate the development of energy on Indian lands by reducing Federal regulations that impede tribal development of Indian lands, and for other purposes (*Native American Energy Act*).

- **H.R. 1825**, To direct Federal public land management officials to exercise their authority under existing law to facilitate use of and access to Federal public lands for fishing, sport hunting, and recreational shooting, and for other purposes (*Recreational Fishing and Hunting Heritage and Opportunities Act*).
- **H.R. 1964**, To amend the Naval Petroleum Reserves Production Act of 1976 to direct the Secretary of the Interior to conduct an expeditious program of competitive leasing of oil and gas in the National Petroleum Reserve in Alaska, including at least one lease sale in the Reserve each year in the period 2013 through 2023, and for other purposes (*National Petroleum Reserve Alaska Access Act*).
- **H.R. 2166**, To direct the Secretary of the Interior and Secretary of Agriculture to expedite access to certain Federal lands under the administrative jurisdiction of each Secretary for good Samaritan search-and-recovery missions, and for other purposes (*Good Samaritan Search and Recovery Act of 2013*).
- **H.R. 2231**, To amend the Outer Continental Shelf Lands Act to increase energy exploration and production on the Outer Continental Shelf, provide for equitable revenue sharing for all coastal States, implement the reorganization of the functions of the former Minerals Management Service into distinct and separate agencies, and for other purposes (*Offshore Energy and Jobs Act*).
