

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 4742
OFFERED BY MR. YOUNG OF ALASKA

At the end of title I add the following:

1 **SEC. ____.** **SUBSISTENCE FISHING.**

2 (a) DEFINITION.—Section 3 (16 U.S.C. 1802) is
3 amended by inserting after paragraph 43 the following:

4 “(43a)(A) The term ‘subsistence fishing’ means
5 fishing in which the fish harvested are intended for
6 customary and traditional uses, including for direct
7 personal or family consumption as food or clothing;
8 for the making or selling of handicraft articles out
9 of nonedible byproducts taken for personal or family
10 consumption, for barter, or sharing for personal or
11 family consumption; and for customary trade.

12 “(B) In this paragraph—

13 “(i) the term ‘family’ means all persons re-
14 lated by blood, marriage, or adoption, or any
15 person living within the household on a perma-
16 nent basis; and

17 “(ii) the term ‘barter’ means the exchange
18 of a fish or fish part—

19 “(I) for another fish or fish part; or

1 “(II) for other food or for nonedible
2 items other than money if the exchange is
3 of a limited and noncommercial nature.”.

4 (b) COUNCIL SEAT.—Section 302(b)(2) (16 U.S.C.
5 1852(b)(2)) is amended—

6 (1) in subparagraph (A), by striking “or rec-
7 reational” and inserting “, recreational, or subsist-
8 ence fishing”; *and*

9 ~~(2) in subparagraph (B), in the first sentence,~~
10 ~~by striking “and recreational” and inserting “, rec-~~
11 ~~reational, and subsistence fishing”; and~~

12 (2) ² in subparagraph (C), in the second sen-
13 tence, by inserting “, and in the case of the Gov-
14 ernor of Alaska with the subsistence fishing interests
15 of the State,” after “interests of the State”.

16 (c) PURPOSE.—Section 2(b)(3) (16 U.S.C.
17 1801(b)(3)) is amended by striking “and recreational”
18 and inserting “, recreational, and subsistence fishing”.
