Mr. JOHNSON of Ohio introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Natural Resources

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## A BILL

To direct the Secretary of the Interior to install in the area of the World War II Memorial in the District of Columbia a suitable plaque or an inscription with the words that President Franklin D. Roosevelt prayed with the United States on June 6, 1944, the morning of D-Day.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “World War II Memo-  
5       rial Prayer Act of 2013”.

1 **SEC. 2. PLACEMENT OF PLAQUE OR INSCRIPTION AT**  
2 **WORLD WAR II MEMORIAL.**

3 The Secretary of the Interior—

4 (1) shall install in the area of the World War  
5 II Memorial in the District of Columbia a suitable  
6 plaque or an inscription with the words that Presi-  
7 dent Franklin D. Roosevelt prayed with the United  
8 States on June 6, 1944, the morning of D-Day;

9 (2) shall design, procure, prepare, and install  
10 the plaque or inscription referred to in paragraph  
11 (1); and

12 (3) may not use Federal funds to prepare or in-  
13 stall the plaque or inscription referred to in para-  
14 graph (1), but may accept and expend private con-  
15 tributions for this purpose.

16 **SEC. 3. COMMEMORATIVE WORKS ACT.**

17 Chapter 89 of title 40, United States Code (com-  
18 monly known as the “Commemorative Works Act”), shall  
19 apply to the design and placement of the plaque within  
20 the area of the World War II Memorial.

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
