Page 110, strike line 11 through page 111, line 5
and insert the following:

1 (1) One member of the House of Representa-
2 tives, who shall be appointed by the Speaker of the
3 House of Representatives, in coordination with the
4 Chairman of the Committee on Natural Resources of
5 the House of Representatives.

6 (2) One member of the House of Representa-
7 tives, who shall be appointed by the Speaker of the
8 House of Representatives, in coordination with the
9 Chairman of the Committee on Ways and Means of
10 the House of Representatives.

11 (3) One member of the House of Representa-
12 tives, who shall be appointed by the Minority Leader
13 of the House of Representatives, in coordination
14 with the ranking minority member of the Committee
15 on Natural Resources of the House of Representa-
16 tives.

17 (4) One member of the House of Representa-
18 tives, who shall be appointed by the Minority Leader
19 of the House of Representatives, in coordination

1 with the ranking minority member of the Committee
2 on Ways and Means of the House of Representa-
3 tives.

4 (5) One member of the Senate, who shall be ap-
5 pointed by the Majority Leader of the Senate, in co-
6 ordination with the Chairman of the Committee on
7 Energy and Natural Resources of the Senate.

8 (6) One member of the Senate, who shall be ap-
9 pointed by the Majority Leader of the Senate, in co-
10 ordination with the Chairman of the Committee on
11 Finance of the Senate.

12 (7) One member of the Senate, who shall be ap-
13 pointed by the Minority Leader of the Senate, in co-
14 ordination with the ranking minority member of the
15 Committee on Energy and Natural Resources of the
16 Senate.

17 (8) One member of the Senate, who shall be ap-
18 pointed by the Minority Leader of the Senate, in co-
19 ordination with the ranking minority member of the
20 Committee on Finance of the Senate.

Page 111, line 7, strike “30” and insert “15”.

Page 111, after line 13, insert the following (and re-
designate provisions accordingly):

1 (f) STATUS UPDATE.—Between September 1, 2016,
2 and September 15, 2016, the Task Force shall provide a
3 status update to the House and Senate that shall in-
4 cludes—

5 (1) information the Task Force has collected;
6 and

7 (2) a discussion on matters the chairman of the
8 Task Force deems urgent for consideration by Con-
9 gress.
